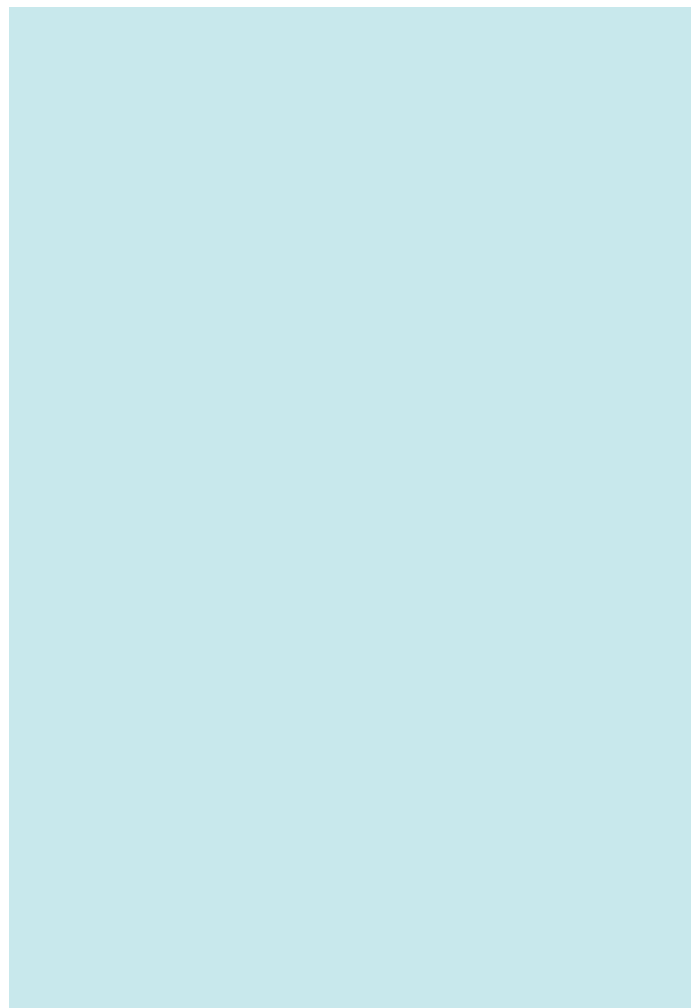

## INTERACTS Consensus Conference on Sarcoma Interventional Oncology

In the last 20 years we have seen significant improvement in the field of Interventional Radiotherapy (brachytherapy)—specifically the implant, planning and delivery within a multidisciplinary approach. The purpose of the Rome INTER-MEETING is to focus on new developments and to improve collaboration between the Italian and European scientific communities.

The meeting aims to support research proposals, such as:

- new randomized controlled clinical trials and prospective population cohort studies
- methodology for building a large database for generating predictive models
- positioning papers on topics with a controversial clinical approach

The topic for our 9th meeting is sarcomas. Our challenge is to identify the role of modern interventional radiotherapy (IRT) in sarcoma patient treatment. An Expert Board, selected by the Scientific Committee on the basis of clinical and research experience in this field, will address the issues and an electronic voting system will help identify consensus.

Consensus statements will be used to finalize a positioning paper.
